

SRVA Tryout, Commitment, and Transfer Policies

Tryout Guidelines for Girls' Youth and Junior Athletes

Tryouts for girls' youth and junior athletes participating in the upcoming USAV season are permitted at any time following the conclusion of the previous season's final Girls' USAV Junior National Championships (Indoor).

Club Invitation and Athlete Commitment

When an athlete or their guardian accepts a club invitation via SportsEngine, this acceptance is considered legally binding for the entire current club season, which begins on September 1st each year. The Southern Region recognizes only this commitment as binding for the duration of the season.

Club Affiliation During the Season

Athletes are permitted to affiliate with only one indoor club throughout the USAV indoor club season. This season concludes with the final USAV Girls' Junior National Championships (Indoor).

Transfer Requests

Requests to transfer athletes to another indoor club are managed according to the Southern Region Athlete/Member Transfer Policy.

Private Agreements and Legal Commitments

Any private business or legal agreements made between a club and a player's family remain the sole responsibility of those parties. The Southern Region does not enforce or take responsibility for private contracts; such agreements exist independently of regional obligations and policies.

Compliance with High School and Collegiate Regulations

Tryout hosts and participants are responsible for ensuring they do not violate any applicable high school or collegiate rules.

Tryout Fees

The maximum fee that may be collected for a tryout is \$78.

Posting the SRVA Tryout Policy

All club websites must prominently display the SRVA tryout policy or provide a link titled “Link to the SRVA Tryout Policy” in the area where tryout information is located.

Acknowledgement of SRVA Rules and Policies

All clubs are required to acknowledge the SRVA rules and policies as outlined in the Handbook and to certify that the SRVA Tryout/Commitment policies were followed during recruiting and forming teams. This certification is mandatory before any team registration can proceed.

Penalties for Policy Violations

Violations of the tryout or commitment policies may result in suspension of the club and potentially the athletes involved from SRVA. In addition, all submitted team or club fees may be revoked and will not be refunded.

Athlete/Member Transfers

An athlete may represent only one club within the same season. Juniors seeking to transfer clubs must obtain permission from their current club, which requires a release in SportsEngine. All permanent transfers are subject to all SRVA-related fees and USAV rules that restrict player participation in qualifiers, Nationals, or other tournaments.
